Gardiner Chess Tournament

Dear Parent/Carer

On **Tuesday 16 March, 2021** we will be participating in the Gardiner Chess Tournament for Term 1, as part of our Birkdale South Chess Club program.

The aims of the activity are to practice our strategic thinking in a competitive situation with other schools, in the Brisbane South zone. Please note that we will be following the school COVID Safe Plan and any special procedures in place.

Activity details:

The event will be taking place at Church of England Grammar School (Churchie) Oaklands Parade, East Brisbane on Tuesday 16 March. The day is conducted by Gardiner Chess and the children are accompanied by Mrs Green and usually one other staff member.

Playing the boardgame "Chess" is a low risk activity, students travel to and from the venue in a maxi taxi. During the competition there is time to break and socialise between rounds.

Students are expected to dress in school uniform, presenting themselves neatly, wearing their hat, and bringing their lunch, water bottle and activities to do between rounds e.g. handball, book (no digital devices).

Activity Costs:

The cost of this activity is \$37. This is made up of \$20 for the tournament and \$17 for the return trip. Should the student be unwell on the day the fees can be refunded.
