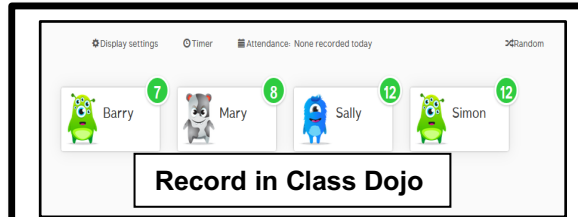

Students are acknowledged for demonstrating any of the 4 school expectations with a Bee Sting.

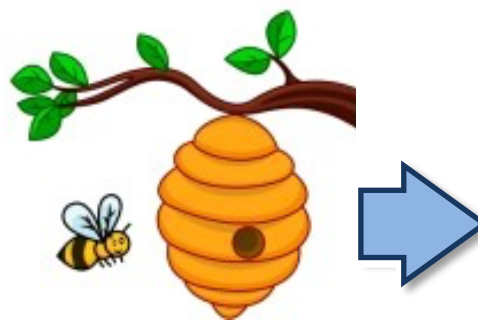
## SPECIALISTS
